Summary Report of CCS Activities 2005

CCS Nepal (NGO) is operating in the area of Thimal (Kavre District), Chitwan and Kathmandu from the beginning of 2004 in the field of education and community development. The projects approved by SWC are granted by CCS Italy (INGO) registered by SWC.

CCS considers education one of the pillars to reduce poverty and to increase human capital.

Following the guidelines of the Agreement signed through SWC with HMG/N, CCS is supporting the primary and secondary education system and creating ECDs in four VDCs Thulo Parsel, Sarmathali, Bolde Pediche, Narayansthan (only primary in Meche, Chapakori). In Chitwan CCS cooperate in managing one school-hostel and built another reserved free of cost to Chepang Children. In Kathmandu CCS cooperates and coordinates local NGOs in the field of prisoners and displaced children assistance and advocacy.

Community mobilization, developing of capacity building and empowerment, partnership are the way of work of CCS worldwide as well the methods used in this projects. We believed that might be a way to reduce the social insecurity produced by the conflict and to help to re-establish better conditions of life.

Women, Dalit, underprivileged ethnic groups are fully involved in the activities we are running in the area and channeled on local SMCs, they cooperate in all phases of the project implementation as well as in monitoring and evaluating it. Community training and auditing are now usual in the area.

About 3400 children are the direct beneficiaries of the project which involve more than 5700 householders.

In collaboration with local SMCs we started micro-projects for income generation and community development.

CCS monitoring shows that the rate of primary schools enrolment in the area increased in the last year from 95% to 98% (ECDs enrollment started in 2004).
