BACKGROUND:

Kavre Palanchok district, though very close to Kathmandu, the capital of the country, lacks behind in various sector like education, health and even in the livelihood. There are such areas as Timal, Danda Pari, Koshi Pari which even have fallen back in course of access to educational and health facilities. They are also far from the transportation access, though some rough trails have been built. The livelihood of the people in these areas is in difficult condition due to poverty, illiteracy and so on. They have to still depend on the traditional ways of agriculture, which can not sustain their livelihood throughout the year. Due to these various reasons, the youngsters of these areas are compelled to go to the urban areas and even to Gulf countries for the employment.

Taking all these accounts into consideration Center For Cooperation and Development, Nepal, known as CCS Nepal in short i.e. a local NGO, has been launching its education, health and livelihood related programs in the seven VDCs of Timal area since 2004 with the supportive grant from its partner INGO, Centro Cooperazione Sviluppo, Italia, commonly known as CCS Italy.

RATIONALE/ CHALLENGES:

At the beginning, CCS Nepal carried out the base line survey, which saw the following challenges:

- Poor and drawback families and children were not enrolled in school
- Lack of child friendly learning environment in classrooms
- Poor healthy environment at schools
- High ratio of drop -out, repeaters and failures in grade one at schools
- Lack of early childhood development among the children of 3-5 years
- Poor physical infrastructures and limited resources at schools
